ART TOUGEAU!

Held on the last Saturday in May!

Where:

Line up in the center lane in front of the Lawrence Art Center, 940 New Hampshire Street (between 9th & 10th Streets, parallel to Massachusetts Street) at 10:30am for registration, check-in & judging. If there are no spots left in the center, park in the metered street parking. Parade will begin around 12 noon. The route will begin at the Arts Center, roll South to 11th St, then right onto Massachusetts Street, heading North on Mass for 4 blocks, parade will turn right (East) onto 7th Street for 1 block, then another Right (heading South again) onto New Hampshire, ending at the Lawrence Arts Center. Awards, presentations and other events will commence immediately after the parade.

How much:

A \$20 entry fee is requested and if it's a business entry its \$50.

As always, kids can enter for free.

We encourage early registration, but allow late entries until just before the parade begins.

All Entries:

- Must be street legal if you plan to drive to and from the parade.
- Must be able to maintain the parade speed of about 5 miles per hour. Check coolant!
- Must be suitable for family viewing. If you want to protest, shock or politic, please organize your own parade. Rudeness, profanity and unsafe behavior of any kind will not be tolerated. Let's carry forward the good reputation we've earned so far.
- Parade organizers will reserve the right to deny entry and participation in the parade.

Be Safe:

- If anyone gets hurt, we'll all feel terrible. Motorized vehicles should carry a fire extinguisher, have good visibility and be mechanically sound. Cyclists and skaters should wear helmets.
- Nothing may be thrown out of motorized vehicles: we don't want kids surging towards the entries as they chase after candy. Let's keep onlookers well back and out from under the wheels. People not in motorized vehicles - with good aim and adequate elbow room—are encouraged to toss candy, trinkets, whatever.

Legal:
